

In attendance: 10 members plus 9 Board members.

Meeting was called to order by President Denise Schneider at 11:10 am.

Minutes: were reviewed by Denise Schneider from the previous October 12th meeting. The motion to accept the minutes was made by Flip Folds and seconded by Debbie. Motion carried.

Financials: were reviewed by Tammy Whaley. October showed a net loss of -\$6,701.92. This was expected because the Wounded Warrior benefit and picnic tables were paid out this month, rather than last month. Last month there was a net income of \$15,872.21. Net Income for year to date is \$12,034.94 and Denise pointed out we are on target to be even for the end of the year, which is where we should be. Flip Folds moved to accept the financials, seconded by Don Schneider. Motion carried.

Bell Jar Report: was given by Jack Vida. The October monthly net increase was \$5,802 following checks were written this month:

The end of the month balance for October Bell Jar is \$34,812.48. The motion to accept the report as read was made by Steve Colvin and seconded by Jules Landy. Motion carried.

Queen of Hearts Report: was given by Bryan Mattison. The current game is up to week 23 with a pot of \$10,376. Doing well. Have four contracts at this point from members who want to continue playing while they are out of town. Week 26 is the last time new players can enter this game.

Membership: Jack Vida read the names of 3 new members and 2 lifetime members approved by the Board at this morning's meeting (see attached list).

Building report: was given by Denise.

Denise reported that Steve Colvin will be taking over the responsibilities of the buildings.

Patio extension: Will be a spring project.

Drop down covering for back wall of pavilion: no update

Cameras: Denise Schneider and Jim Fowler working on this, will get a quote from Volney Multiplex.

Picnic Tables: Six of the old tables have been sold and seven were donated.

Foam Installation: Denise to follow up with the company that Steve Fayette had recommended.

Pavilion Kitchen: Looking for a member to look at the kitchen area and make suggestions and estimate the cost to remodel the area. No Update

Handicap Ramp: The ramp that was on the marketplace needed too much modification for our purpose. Will continue to investigate other options, but Steve Colvin will make sure the current ramp is useable and safe for the winter.

Property Survey: Denise is trying to find out if the club has ever had a survey done on all its property lines. No one present knew for sure. Tammie Whaley suggested that Denise contact the Oswego County Property office.

Events: Denise updated events that occurred since our last meeting.

- October 18th was the Children's Halloween party hosted by Cyndi Wood. There were about 20 kids in attendance and a great time for all.
- October 25th was the Adult Halloween party. Entertainment was Terry and Joe, and the party was held upstairs with great costumes and over all a fantastic night.

Upcoming Events:

- November 12th will be the Veteran's drawing for members of the club who are veterans who entered the raffle. The prize is either \$100 or a lifetime membership.
- Thanksgiving week the Angel Tree will be up in the Bar. Denise Schneider is coordinating.
- December 13th is the Children's Christmas party (noon-2pm) hosted by Shawn Barnett & friends.
- December 20th is the Adult Christmas party. Entertainment is going to be by Dave Domicolo, and the party will be held upstairs.

Bar Manager: Abby Colvin reported all is going well. There are Turkey raffles on Friday evenings during Happy Hour. There is a new bartender starting today, Amber Connelly.
