

SPSA Member Meeting – July 12, 2026

Minutes

In attendance: 8 members plus 6 Board members.

Meeting was called to order by President Denise Schneider at 11:03 am.

Minutes: were reviewed by Denise from the previous June 14, 2026, meeting. The motion to accept the minutes was made by Steve Colvin and seconded by Frank Salvett. Motion carried.

Financials: were reviewed by Treasurer Tammie Whaley. June showed a net loss of - \$31,438.33. Denise and Tammy explained, \$36,952.21 was paid out on the building project, however the loan money is deposited in the Pathfinder Bank and does not show as revenue, therefore it appears to be a huge net loss for the month. While it appears as a net loss, the club is doing fine, and the day-to-day operation income has been up from last year. The motion was made to accept the financials was made by Steve Colvin and seconded by Frank Salvett. Motion carried.

Bell Jar Report: was given by Jack Vida. The monthly June net increase was \$10,743. The following checks were written this month:

- National Child Safety Council (Oswego County Sheriff) - \$200
- Pulaski Relay for Life Donation - \$100
- Central Oswego County Riders ATV Club Sponsorship - \$1000
- Ralston Supply Center (supplies for pull tabs) - \$2,391.05

The end of the month balance for June was \$55,657.44. The motion to accept the report as read was made by Tammie Whaley and seconded by Judy Phillips. Motion carried.

Queen of Hearts Report: was given by Denise. The current game is up to week 25 with a pot of \$6,881. Tomorrow July 13th is the 26th week. Today and tomorrow (until game time) is the last time that new people can join this game. (This is a house rule) three cards will be drawn tomorrow night (Week 26)

Membership: Jack Vida read the names of 16 new members approved by the Board at this morning's meeting (see attached list). Welcome All!

Building report: was given by Denise.

- Capital Project – the new wiring has been run to make it up to current code. The foam insulation has been installed, other than the area above the bathrooms. The HVAC unit has been installed and ductwork is in progress. As soon as complete, the pine ceiling will be installed and the room painted.
- Pavilion Roof – needs repair and supplies have been purchased.
- Garage Roof – seals on roof needs replacing.
- Siding on corner of club house – Vicky Gregory brought to the attention of members that some of the siding on the corner of the building is off and needs to be replaced.
- Other projects are on hold at this time.

Events: Denise updated on events that occurred since our last meeting.

- \$25.00 to the local chapter of the Pheasants Forever Organization for a ¼ page add in their publication.
